

Product Structure Diagram



Robot Button




After customizing the cleaning area and duration within the App, these settings will be synchronized to the custom mode button.


Installation

1. Side Brush


Attach one end of the brush to the protrusion




- 2. Clarifying Agent Kit
- Remove the cap and tear off the aluminum film




- 3. Charging Dock
- Install the bracket properly




2 Rotate the brush around the hub and secure the other end to the protrusion



2 Install it onto the robot with the interface facing down




2 Place the robot onto it and start charging




Preparations Before Cleaning


Make sure the robot is sufficiently charged




3 Place the robot on a level surface and wait for about 5s for it to calibrate



2 Select the cleaning mode



4 Put the robot into the water gently to start



Network Configuration


1. APP Download

Scan the QR code to download the latest version of the App You can either scan the QR code or search for "Beatbot" in the App Store or Google Play to download the latest App.



2. Robot Connection

Press the "Power" and "Floor Mode" buttons simultaneously for about 3s, and when you see the indicator flashing blue, the robot is ready for network setup. Then, you can choose either of the following methods to complete the connection:



- Make sure your robot is turned on.
- Make sure both your phone and robot are on the same strong Wi-Fi network and within 1 m of each other.

Precautions Before Use



Before cleaning, please make sure there are no foreign objects such as towels or toys in the pool.



Avoid animals and people from entering the pool during cleaning.



For optimal cleaning results, it's recommended to operate the robot separately from the circulation



If it's your first time using the pool this season, manually remove any large debris first. Then, use the robotic pool cleaner to maintain cleanliness. Starting with manual cleaning prevents the robot's filter from clogging quickly due to leftover debris.
